

## Batteries contact test

### 1- Remove the cover to access the batteries.

- Remove the batteries and you will be able to verify the contacts as shown in the second picture.
- If you have dropped the remote, the contact tabs may be bent and result a bad contact. Usually when shaking the remote, you should hear the batteries move a little bit inside.

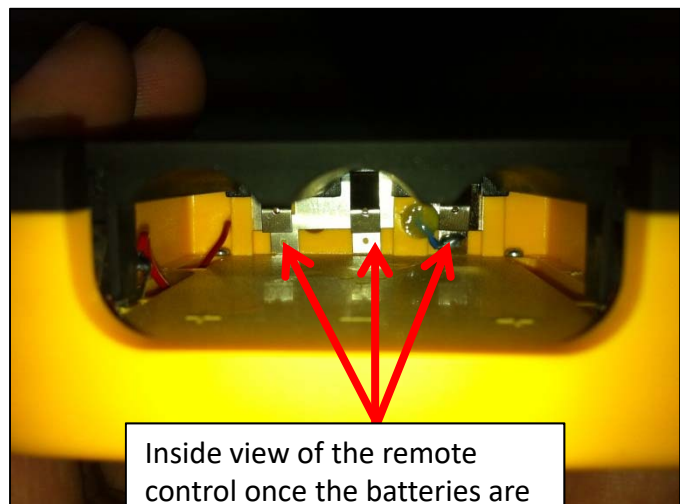


### 2- Straighten the tabs.

- With a flat screwdriver or with long-nose pliers, pull out slightly on the tabs and do a test with the remote control to be sure it works.

**Tools needed:** Flat screwdriver / long nose plier

**Time required:** 5 minutes
