Cleaning of a check valve

When the flapper is not working properly or not working at all, a dirt is probably stuck inside. By pushing on it with a screwdriver, the moving purpose must move easily. Follow the next steps to extract it.

- With a snap ring pliers, remove the snap ring and take care to not lose the spring and the cover that will go out.
- 2. Remove the 3 movable parts (the seat, the spring and the cover).
- 3. With an air blow gun, give off the debris from inside the valve and clean up the parts if needed in a cleaning parts bin.
- Place back the components carefully and make sure that the snap ring is well placed in its groove.

- 15 minutes
